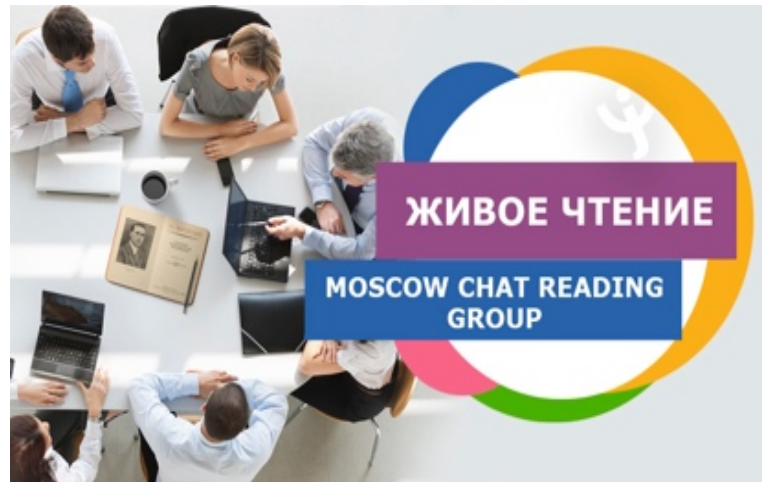

CULTURAL-HISTORICAL PSYCHOLOGY IN MSUPE PROJECTS (2)



The "Vygotzky's Library" project – a knowledge base on the cultural-historical and activity psychology, which can serve as an effective tool for systematic and comprehensive research, educational and practical activities for the specialists interested in it.

During the period of implementation of the 1st stage of the "Vygotzky's Library" project, the following were created: the "Vygotzky's Library" fund of academic, methodological, scientific and practical publications on paper, consisting of 348 titles; the fund of the electronic collection of the "Cultural-Historical Psychology" on the platform of the electronic library of MSUPE, consisting of 379 works. The total number of sources is over 600 titles.
