CULTURAL-HISTORICAL PSYCHOLOGY JOURNAL: ORIGINS AND ROOTS



The international journal "Cultural-Historical Psychology" was founded in 2005.

The founder and publisher of the journal is Moscow State University of Psychology and Education (MSUPE). The idea of creating the journal belonged to V.P. Zinchenko, V.V. Rubtsov (president of MSUPE), A.A. Margolis (rector of MSUPE), V.M. Munipov, and B.G. Meshcheryakov.





Since the moment of the journal foundation, Vladimir Petrovich Zinchenko was its permanent chief editor. Boris Daniilovich Elkonin became the second editor-in-chief in 2014.

The Chairman of the editorial council is Vitaliy Rubtsov. The Deputy chairman of the editorial council is Arkadiy Margolis.



CHP JOURNAL & ISCAR: EXPERTS



In 2006 the journal became officially affiliated with the International Society for Cultural and Activity Research (ISCAR).

Cooperation with ISCAR is regularly based. Among members of the editorial board, there are famous names in the field of cultural-historical psychology, including ISCAR members: Manolis Dafermos (Greece); Harry Daniels (Great Britain); Michael Cole (USA); Alex Kozulin (Israel), Ludvigsen, Sten (Norway); Katerina Plakitsa (Greece); Serena Veggetti (Italy), Tatyana Akhutina (Russia); Aleksandr Venger (Russia); Galina Tsukerman (Russia) and others.

CHP JOURNAL & ISCAR: THEMATIC ISSUES



4 thematic issues of the journal "Cultural-Historical Psychology" have been created together with ISCAR and now the 5th issue is being prepared for publication.

In 2020 – the first issue Cultural-Historical Psychology: Traditions and Innovations (Vol. 16, no. 2 – https://psyjournals.ru/en/kip/2020/n2/)

In 2020 – the second issue Cultural-Historical Psychology: Traditions and Innovations (Vol. 16, no. 3 – https://psyjournals.ru/en/kip/2020/n3)

In 2021 – the issue Cultural-Historical Theory and Activity Approach: Social and Educational Practices (Vol. 17, no. 2 – https://psyjournals.ru/en/kip/2021/n2/) with continuation in Vol. 17, no. 3.



Conceptualization of the classics of cultural-historical psychology and work with unique archives is a separate task of the journal. The journal began with the publication of previously unpublished works by Lydia Bozhovich, and 4 unpublished lectures by Lev Vygotsky will see the light in 2021 year (Cultural-Historical Theory and Activity Approach: Social and Educational Practices).

MSUPE - 14 JOURNALS



In total, MSUPE is a publisher of 14 scientific journals. Cultural-historical and activity topics are presented and welcomed in each of them. In addition to the journal "Cultural-Historical Psychology", MSUPE publishes the following journals:

Counseling Psychology and Psychotherapy (1992); Psychological Science and Education (1996); Autism and Developmental Disorders (2003); Experimental Psychology (2008); Psychological-Educational Studies (2009); Social Psychology and Society (2010); Clinical Psychology and Special Education (2012); Language and Text (2014); Psychology and Law (2010); Modelling and Data Analysis (2011); Journal of Modern Foreign Psychology (2012); Bulletin of Psychological Practice in Education (2019); Social Sciences and Childhood (2020).





PLATFORM PSYJOURNALS.RU IN NUMBERS



In 2006 in order to support the development of a scientific approach in psychology, MSUPE created an electronic psychology repository – PsyJournals.ru, which contains a complete archive collection of articles of all the 14 MSUPE journals for more than 25 years.

Psyjournals.ru is the largest *thematic* platform in Russia for scientific journals and proceedings on psychology.

Total number of visitors Psyjournals.ru in 2020 – 1.07 million (~2923 visitors per day). Articles of journals – 10950 (of which 685 are in English). About 600 new articles are posted per year. Proceedings – 96.



The placement of monographs has become a new direction of the portal's development. Now the portal has already posted 10 books.

One of the novelties: Joint educational activities and development of children, Collective monograph edited by V.V. Rubtsov and I.M. Ulanovskaya (2021).

PsyJournals.ru is included in the international ranking of academic repositories The Ranking Web of World repositories (CSIC) and ranks 66th out of 257 international repositories (Transparent Ranking, May 2021).



ACHIEVEMENTS OF MSUPE JOURNALS



It should be noted that along with recognition in Russian national rankings and recommended lists, the journals of MSUPE publishing house have found international recognition – **4** journals are included in the Scopus database, **7** journals are included in the Web of Science Core Collection (Emerging Sources Citation Index, ESCI). CHP Journal is in both of them.

Speaking about the recognition of our journals, it is necessary to indicate their place in the Scopus database – the quartiles that include MSUPE journals.




"In order to stand, I must hold the roots" – as one famous song says.
